USTA Team Rules for LTYC Captains

Team captains should know if there are matches or court time scheduled directly after their scheduled match times. To be courteous to other members and visitors, ensure that your matches start on time and that time on change-overs is limited to 2 minutes in this case.

Please ensure that changes to the schedule are approved by the league coordinator **AND** Joe Donell.

Ensure that your scheduled matches appear on the club electronic calendar.

Court Water Schedule

We are heading into the dry season. Court moisture is paramount to maintaining the current excellent condition of our Har-tru courts. To that end I have instituted a mandatory watering schedule and have lock the irrigation control box. Watering will take place Monday-Friday at 1PM and Saturday and Sunday at 3PM. If there is a conflict with these times, please contact me AT LEAST ONE DAY IN ADVANCE at 717.682.1933. Thank you for your support.

Lifetime Tennis Membership

There are still lifetime memberships available however only 20 will be issued.

- Assuming reasonable membership price increases, in 9 years, the regular membership price will be at least \$550/year. So that is your yearly savings after the payback period.
